FAQ from Post-Secondary Presentation (October 2023)

Hopefully most of the answers are in the presentation (also available on the Merivale Student Services Post-Secondary page). There were a few additional questions that were addressed during the Q & A after the presentation. Please see below.

What courses are considered for Admission?

COLLEGE:

- Colleges will consider program prerequisites for admission.
- ENG4U and ENG4C are considered as equivalents for admission.

UNIVERSITY:

- It depends on where in the admission cycle students are being considered
 - Early admission cycles (prior to February mid-terms) universities are considering a combination of grade 11 final grades and first quarter grade 12 grades.
 - Early admission cycles universities will consider student's top 5 including prerequisites for the program UNLESS they have 2 or more completed grade 12 credits. In this case, universities will consider student's top 6 including prerequisites for the program.
 - February May admission cycles universities will consider student's top 6 grade 12 credits including prerequisites for the program.

More and more universities are asking for <u>supplemental applications</u>. This can take MANY different forms. <u>DEADLINES are university specific</u>. The details for each school and each program will be available to students after they apply on the university portal.

After choosing programs and making the payment on OUAC, can you still apply to more? Or do you need to apply to every program at once?

 Students can return to their OUAC account to add or change applications at any point in the admission cycle.

If you have more than one offer and accept one, do other offers get declined automatically?


• Once the student has accepted an offer, they will no longer be considered for admission to other institutions in Ontario.

Do universities consider summer school, eLearning, or night school for admission?


- Most universities accept all approved courses through schools accredited bt the Ministry of Education.
- Some universities (University of Waterloo) may ask students to explain why they took the course outside of their day school. Sometimes, taking required courses in summer school could negatively affect a student's application to some programs.
